The CLI Model for School Improvement was designed to offer processes for meeting academic mandates, including accreditation. It aligns closely with most accreditation agency standards.

Systemic indicators such as leadership, communication, culture, and policy.



Directional indicators such as processes, cohesiveness, and purpose.



Curriculum indicators such as rigor, alignment to standards, and equity.



Instructional indicators such as strategies, mentoring, and collaboration.



Assessment indicators such as grading, reporting, data collection, and usage.
